

Nursing Level Program Learning Outcomes

Students completing the Associate Degree Nursing program will be able to:

1. Examine relevant technology for client care and documentation.
2. Apply foundational knowledge of the nursing process in providing nursing care for clients throughout the lifespan.
3. Formulate a teaching/learning plan for culturally diverse clients with selected health alterations in a variety of settings.
4. Demonstrate proficiency in performing nursing skills for individuals with health alterations.
